It's Time to Renew Your Membership for 2019-2020

In Article III Membership, Section 3 Dues of GFWC Legacy's bylaws, it reads

Annual dues of \$45 per year shall be payable to the Treasurer no later than the April meeting to avoid a \$10 late fee. All dues not paid by the May meeting will be considered delinquent and membership in Club will be forfeited. Any former member who has forfeited membership and wishes to be reinstated will be required to pay \$45 dues plus an additional \$10 delinquent fee.
